I. Guidelines

EIT Manufacturing Co-Location Center (CLC) East in partnership with the Vienna Business Agency (VBA) organizes the "Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition — powered by EIT Manufacturing CLC East" programme for thriving start-ups and scale-ups that have solutions in the realm of manufacturing technologies.

Vienna is well known for its human-centered approach in designing one of the most livable cities in the world. The city has a long-lasting history of creativity and cultural heritage. With over 8,500 companies creating over 12.3 billion EUR revenue, the manufacturing sector enables future-oriented jobs and drives growth and innovation in the city.

"Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition" is designed for start-ups and scale-ups in the manufacturing sector with a geographical focus on CEE countries and Austria. Teams and companies from the following countries are eligible to take part in "Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition": Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Greece, Hungary, North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, and Slovenia.

Participants of Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition compete for dedicated support services provided by EIT Manufacturing CLC East and the Vienna Business Agency. The dedicated support services are organised in two packages, and participants are free to choose only one according to their needs:

<u>Package 1</u>: Intensive programme in Vienna during the ViennaUP'22 festival (30.05.2022 – 03.06.2022). The programme includes:

- Two months of mentoring and coaching support with focus on business development and investment readiness provided by EIT Manufacturing CLC East.
- Five days all-expenses-paid stay in Vienna during the ViennaUP'22 festival (except for teams and start-ups/scale-ups based in Vienna).
- Intensive access-to-market programme to get acquainted with the dynamics in the Austrian and Viennese markets provided by the VBA and EIT Manufacturing CLC East.
- Five days free office space in the offices of EIT Manufacturing CLC East in the Technology Centre Seestadt in Vienna, Austria.
- Deep dive sessions and introduction to leading Austrian industrial corporates and investors.
- 250.00 EUR Travel voucher provided by EIT Manufacturing CLC East (Not valid for start-ups from Vienna).
- Visibility and international publicity.
- Up to 10 selected start-ups/scale-ups will be nominated as finalists and pitch at the BoostUp! East Finals event on 1st June 2022 within the ViennaUP'22.
- The winners of the BoostUp! East Finals will get a fast-track ticket to EIT Manufacturing's business creation services and deal flow for funding of up to 300.000 Euro.

Package 2: Light programme in Vienna (31.05.2022 and 01.06.2022). The programme includes:

- Two months of mentoring and coaching support with focus on business development and investment readiness provided by EIT Manufacturing CLC East.
- Two days all-expenses-paid stay in Vienna during the ViennaUP'22 festival (except for teams and start-ups/scale-ups based in Vienna).
- Two days free office space in the offices of EIT Manufacturing CLC East in the Technology Centre Seestadt in Vienna, Austria.
- 250,00 EUR Travel voucher provided by EIT Manufacturing CLC East (Not valid for start-ups from Vienna).
- Visibility and international publicity.
- Up to 10 selected start-ups/scale-ups will be nominated as finalists and pitch at the BoostUp! East Finals event on 1st June 2022 within the ViennaUP'22.
- The winners of the BoostUp! East Finals will get a fast-track ticket to EIT Manufacturing's business creation services and deal flow for funding of up to 300.000 Euro.

The Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition programme will culminate with a **BoostUp! East Finals** event where Industry 4.0 and 5.0 start-ups and scale-ups will have the opportunity to pitch their innovative solutions and to compete for prizes in two categories: **"Switch On"** and **"Supercharge"**. Access to the fast track to EIT Manufacturing's business creation services and deal flow for funding of up to 300,000 Euro will be possible for the start-ups and scale-ups that win the 1st place in the BoostUp! East Finals 2022 in the categories 'Switch On' and 'Supercharge'.

The programme is aiming to find the best solutions for sustainable, resilient, and socially impactful manufacturing. Winners will also gain access to EIT Manufacturing's pan-European innovation network

and enjoy visibility and international publicity through EIT Manufacturing's and VBA's communication channels.

II. Requirements for entry

Submissions need to fit one of the following **EIT Manufacturing flagship areas:**

- Flexible Production Systems for Competitive Manufacturing Emerging technologies enable almost limitless flexibility in product design and production, allowing full customisation.
- Low Environmental Footprint Systems & Circular Economy for Green Manufacturing Using new technology to minimise the use of resources, energy, and material in production systems enables new circular business models.
- **Digital & Collaborative Solutions for Innovative Manufacturing Ecosystems** Collaboration and business on digital platforms and value networks enables companies to create new and highly efficient value chains.
- Human-machine co-working for socially sustainable manufacturing Smart use of automation and robots enables great workplaces, flexible production, and sustainable human work.

as well as the following technology domains: Simulation & Advanced Engineering Tools, Industrial VR/AR, Industrial Robotics, Logistics Tech, Additive Manufacturing (3D Printing), Predictive Maintenance, Advanced Sensors, Advanced Detection (IR/Noise/etc.), Industrial Cybersecurity, Connectivity and IoT Infrastructure, Data analytics/AI, Digital Twins and Green Manufacturing Tech.

Start-ups and scale-ups can apply in two categories:

Category **Switch On** for early-stage start-ups and teams that fulfil the following criteria:

- An entrepreneurial team or legal entity, with a minimum of two members, is eligible to take part in the competition;
- In case of an established legal entity, it should be established between 2020 2022;
- Team members or legal entity must be resident in one of the CLC East countries;
- Submission needs to fit at least one of EIT Manufacturing's Flagship areas;
- The proposed solution should be in min. TRL 6.

Category Supercharge for start-ups and scale ups with traction that fulfil the following criteria:

- Company must be incorporated in one of the CLC East countries and should not be older than 8 years;
- Applicants have to prove revenue traction (existing reference customers);
- The business development plans (incl. financial aspects) shall be disclosed.

III. The Application and Selection Process

"Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition" will award applicants as selected by EIT Manufacturing CLC East, the Vienna Business Agency and appointed third-party expert and investor jury members.













EIT Manufacturing CLC East is responsible for coordinating and overseeing the application and evaluation process.

Step 1: Submit the application

All applications must be submitted in English using the application form here – no paper submissions will be considered.

Submissions will be accepted from March 8th, 2022. There will be three cut-off dates – April 1st, April 15th and May 3rd. After each cut-off date, the applications received until that date will be evaluated and all positively assessed start-ups and scale-ups will be selected for the programme. In total, up to 15 start-ups and scale-ups will be selected to participate in the programme and as soon as this number is reached, the application period will be closed.

Only applications submitted through the online link (as noted above) before the deadline will be accepted and considered.

The organizers reserve the right to extend the submission deadline or cut-off dates; any extension of the deadline will be communicated publicly on the call website.

Step 2: Assessment by the jury

The evaluation and selection process of the "Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition" call is designed to create an open, accountable, multi-step selection process based solely on the merit of the submitted applications. All submissions shall receive the same opportunity. No quotas shall be established.

Each eligible submitted application shall be evaluated by the jury which is nominated by the organizer.

During the selection, the jury members will individually evaluate each application according to the following main assessment criteria:

- Addressed market needs/customer pain points;
- Product/service innovativeness;
- 3. Value proposition (product/solution);
- 4. Market and competition;
- 5. Team, expertise, and entrepreneurial drive;
- 6. Strategic alignment to the competition areas;

The criteria can be rated from 1 to 5, where 1 is for "no fit" and 5 is for "excellence". The maximum score per application is 30 points. Based on the collective results of the individual assessments, a deliberation meeting will be held to decide which applicants (up to 15) will be invited to join the programme.

Step 3: Prizes and follow-up

For delivery of the prizes noted above, the following steps will be taken after closing the selection procedure:











- Signature of the 2-months support agreement. The two-month long mentoring and coaching programme will begin immediately upon signing the agreement.
- Delivery of "growth package" support services by the EIT Manufacturing Business Creation team.
- Start-up's participation on-site for the "Discover Vienna: Manufacturing Edition" programme between May 30th and June 3rd, 2022.

IV. Intellectual Property and Publication Rights

Participants retain full and exclusive ownership of their prior information and intellectual property rights. By submitting their application, participants affirm that they hold ownership or have legally secured the right to use all elements of the innovative product or service. Participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless EIT Manufacturing and/or any assignee or affiliate from any third-party allegations or claims of intellectual property rights infringement by the product or service of participants. Participants shall have the right to further develop, use, and license their intellectual property rights for creating, making, marketing, and distributing products, services and technology. By submitting their application, winners agree to the possible inclusion of their product or service in any media coverage by EIT Manufacturing and its partners, such as press releases or publications. Also, all winners and finalists agree that their personal data, such as their names and affiliations, pictures, videos, and sounds may be used for such purposes by EIT Manufacturing and its partners.

V. Data protection

The sole purpose of the collection of data is to verify the eligibility of the submitted products or services and to identify the best projects/companies. Participants will provide name, postal address, email address and telephone number ("personal data") only for the purposes related to execution of the competition. EIT Manufacturing will process the submitted material according to the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Participants have the possibility to indicate that EIT Manufacturing may grant access to parts of their submission to trusted investors and partners. The application submission and evaluation process will be done via Submittable (https://www.submittable.com/), an online submission management tool by Submittable Holdings, Inc.

YOUR CONSENT TO THE USE OF SUBMITTABLE AS SUBMISSION AND EVALUATION TOOL: By submitting your application within this challenge you implicitly state your consent to the Terms and Conditions as well as the Privacy policy of Submittable. YOUR CONSENT TO THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA: By submitting your application within this competition you consent that EIT Manufacturing will collect, transfer, process, store and delete your data in accordance with the aforementioned conditions.

VI. Acceptance of Rules and Regulations

By submitting the application form, the participant agrees to the Rules and Regulations, which form part of the submission. Participants agree that they have no legal entitlement to a prize. EIT Manufacturing reserves the right to make reasonable amendments to these Rules and Regulations.

Amendments and additions to these Rules and Regulations shall be valid only if communicated in writing or otherwise made available to the participants. Any deviation from these Rules and Regulations can only be made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of EIT Manufacturing and the participant. These Rules and Regulations are governed by the laws of Austria. Any disagreement or dispute which may arise in connection with these Rules and Regulations which cannot be settled amicably will be brought before the courts in Vienna, Austria. To the maximum extent permitted by law, under no circumstances and under no legal theory whether in tort (including negligence) contract otherwise shall EIT Manufacturing, any of its Co-Location Centers or affiliates be liable for any special indirect, punitive, incidental or consequential damages, including loss of profit. The liability of EIT Manufacturing shall in any case be limited to 1,000 EUR.
